Conflict Minerals Declaration

LaminaCore Solutions confirms that, to the best of our knowledge, no tungsten, tantalum, or gold is used in our products. Some of the raw materials we use, including CRGO and related electrical steels, may contain trace amounts of tin. In such cases, we confirm that the tin is sourced exclusively from approved smelters listed as conflict-free under the Responsible Minerals Assurance Process (RMAP). This declaration applies to all materials supplied to customers as of 2023 and aligns with the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI) framework.

LaminaCore Solutions confirms that, to the best of our knowledge, no tin, tungsten, tantalum, or gold (3TG) used in our products is sourced from Conflict-Affected or High-Risk Areas (CAHRAs), including the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or adjoining countries.

This declaration applies to all materials supplied to customers as of 2023 and aligns with the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI) framework.

We require all direct suppliers to complete and return a Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT) annually, confirming either:

- No 3TG minerals in supplied materials, or
- 3TG sources and smelters listed with certification as conflict-free.

We expect suppliers to source 3TG only from smelters/refiners validated through third-party audits such as the RMI's Responsible Minerals Assurance Process (RMAP).

Suppliers with identified risk exposures are periodically reviewed and monitored. LaminaCore commits to annual updates of this declaration and continuous improvement of our sourcing transparency practices.
